24	to a complete resolution of the above-captioned matter as follows:		
25	RECITALS:		
26	A. The independent accounting firm of Clifton Larson Allen, LLP (Auditor),		
27	conducted an audit of the Appellant for the 2016-17 fiscal year, the results of which were		
28	included in the final audit report issued on or about December 11, 2017.		

1 Β. In Audit Finding 2017-001, the Auditor determined that the Appellant was not in 2 compliance with Education Code sections 46113 and 46144, subdivision (b), which require 3 minimum school day minutes, resulting in an overstatement in the amount of apportionment the 4 Appellant claimed from the State in the amount of \$197,000. 5 C. Appellant timely filed a request for formal appeal of Audit Finding 2017-001 6 pursuant to Education Code Section 41344, subdivision (d), instituting this appeal before the 7 Education Audit Appeals Panel (EAAP). 8 To avoid the cost and uncertainty of litigation, the Parties to this case agree to D. 9 resolve this dispute on the terms and conditions described below. 10 AGREEMENT 11 For purposes of completely settling and resolving Audit Finding 2017-001, the Parties 12 agree as set forth below: 13 1. Appellant shall repay in full satisfaction of the Audit Finding 2017-001 the sum of 14 \$150,000, with no interest, to be paid in full within a period of one year from the approval of this 15 agreement by the EAAP. 16 2. This Stipulation and Settlement Agreement is subject to and conditioned upon 17 approval and adoption by EAAP, pursuant to Education Code section 41344.1, subdivision (b), 18 and upon ratification by the Appellant's Governing Board. 19 3. This Stipulation and Settlement Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each 20 of which shall constitute an original. Facsimile and electronic, or pdf, signatures by the Parties 21 and/or their designated representatives are deemed the equivalent of original signatures. 22 4.
